City workers made women walk in circles on top of a giant red cube today to highlight gender inequality.

American artist Kate Gilmore, 35, whose work *Walk the Line* was unveiled in Exchange Square today, said she wanted to turn their mundane working life into a dramatic visual spectacle. Teams of women wearing matching dresses walked without a break for 10 hours.

Jeni Hallam, 21, an arts graduate from Brixton, said: "There's still a lot of chauvinism. This might bring it to people's consciousness."
