

THE CORPORATIZATION OF WYNWOOD

Is Wynwood the next to fall? A telltale sign that the neighborhood's homegrown culture is petering out is pioneering art gallerist David Castillo's recent decampment from the area to Lincoln Road (of all places). His new venue is in the Art Deco building by Albert Anis, complete with lobby murals by Leo Birchansky. "It was always my dream to be in a historic building," Castillo says. "Entering the space gives one pause and reminds us of the continuity of art." In conjunction with the gallery's grand opening, it celebrates its tenth anniversary and 101st exhibit with multimedia group show *Amerika* through mid-November.
