Miami's **David Castillo Gallery** is presenting two solo shows, **Susan Lee-Chun**'s *It's a pleasure (not) to meet you* and **Jillian Mayer**'s *Day Off*, opening April 14 and running to May 31.

Both shows by the Miami-based artists insist upon the primacy of material culture in the politics of representation. Lee-Chun's objects and sculptures will move between display, fiction, artefact and kitsch, while certain social narratives underscore the personal subjectivity at stake in the materiality of culturally-produced objects, and Mayer will bring her *Slumpies* series to the space.

Mayer's work in *Day Off* will show the vulnerability of bodies in virtual space, slumping, encumbered by head sets, and viewed in a video in a gallery to suggest that culture must account for the materiality of its digital production and use.
