The trailer for Matthew McConaughey's war-on-drugs film *White Boy Rick* makes the crack epidemic look like an awesome **roller-skating** party.


A Pennsylvania school gave its students bulletproof shields for their eighth-grade graduation. Remember when schools just distributed **condoms** for protection?

A\$AP Rocky ft. Frank Ocean's **contemplative** "Purity."




... Hey, the 1990s are so **on-trend**, maybe someone should bring back Marion's Continental, which used to be there?
