The highlight of Miami Beach's year-end celebrations is no doubt <u>Art Basel 2016</u>. Now in its 15th year, the prominent North American art fair will showcase 269 exhibitors inside the 500,000 square-foot Miami Beach Convention Center. Between December 1 and 4, amid a flurry of Miami Art Week <u>satellite fairs</u>, <u>parties</u> and <u>events</u>, Basel attendees will have the opportunity to browse works exhibited by big-name artists and influential galleries across sections that include Nova (younger galleries), Survey (historical works) and Positions (made up of emerging artists).
