7. Wynwood Art District, Miami

Won't be in town for the annual <u>Art Basel Miami Beach</u> and its 3 squajillion related exhibits? Never fear. The six dozen exhibit spaces in Miami's Wynwood Art District offer enough visual stimulation to induce a permanent case of Stendahl Syndrome. Start with one of the private collections: the <u>Rubell Family Collection</u>, <u>Margulies Collection at the Warehouse</u> or <u>World Class Boxing</u>. Here, you'll find expansive displays that run the gamut from Isamu Noguchi to Kara Walker. Still standing? Time to hit the galleries. For top-tier local artists, such as Hernan Bas and Glexis Novoa, visit the highly regarded <u>Fredric Snitzer Gallery</u> and <u>David Castillo</u>. During summer months, some places may be closed, so call ahead.
