DoDo Unveils Exclusive Collaboration with Sanford Biggers at Art Basel Miami Beach

DoDo, the iconic Italian jewelry house under Kering, is making a defining statement at Art Basel Miami Beach with an exclusive new collaboration alongside internationally renowned American artist Sanford Biggers. Unveiled during one of the world's leading art fairs, this limited-edition capsule collection bridges contemporary art and fine jewelry in a way that feels both culturally relevant and visually magnetic.

The collection draws inspiration from Biggers' celebrated *Unsui* series, known for its cloud-like forms that explore ideas of movement, freedom, and transformation. DoDo translates this artistic language into four genderless Cloud Charms, each meticulously handcrafted in Italy and personally signed by the artist.

The capsule includes two small charms in sterling silver and 9K rose gold accented with black diamonds, a medium charm in sterling silver, and a bold sculptural large charm crafted in sterling silver. Every piece reflects DoDo's exacting craftsmanship while honoring the soft-yet-structured cloud motif that defines Biggers' work, resulting in jewelry that doubles as wearable sculpture.

This launch also marks a historic moment for Art Basel Miami Beach. For the first time, the Art Basel Shop is presenting a jewelry collaboration with an artist—a milestone that underscores the growing convergence between fine art, design, and high-end craftsmanship. As collectors increasingly seek pieces that blend cultural significance with aesthetic impact, the DoDo x Sanford Biggers capsule emerges as a standout example of how art can move beyond the gallery and into everyday expression.

What makes this collaboration especially compelling is the way it reimagines jewelry as a medium for storytelling. Biggers' work often reflects on cultural layering, spiritual journeys, and the fluidity of identity, and DoDo transforms those themes into pieces meant to be worn close to the body. The charms become conversation starters—objects that not only elevate a look but also invite deeper reflection on the ideas that shaped them.
